DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake container vigorously before use.

- 1. Sweep loose soils from floor.
- 2. Vary solution strength based on the soil load.
 - a. For heavy soils make a 4 oz: 1 Gal (10 oz: 2½ Gal) cleaning solution.
 - b. For medium soils make a 3 oz: 1 Gal (7½ oz: 2½ Gal) cleaning solution.
 - c. For light soils or to maintain a clean floor, make a 1½ oz to 1 oz: 1 Gal (3 oz to 2½ Gal) cleaning solution.
- 3. Mop floor. For heavy soil buildup vigorously scrub the soiled areas with a deck brush or a saturated mop.
- 4. Wring mop and remove excess solution.
- 5. Air dry. No rinsing required.
