DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Normal soils:

- 1) Sweep floor.
- 2) Add 2-4 oz. of H.D. Floor Cleaner to 1 gallon of hot water.
- 3) Apply generously to floor with a mop.
- 4) Let solution soak 5-10 minutes.
- 5) For best results scrub, with deck brush.
- 6) Remove from floor with a clean damp mop, rinsing frequently

Heavy, gross soils:

- 1) Sweep floor and wet with hot water.
- 2) Heavily sprinkle cleaner on soiled areas.
- 3) Soak for 5-7 minutes.
- 4) Follow steps 2-6 noted above.
